

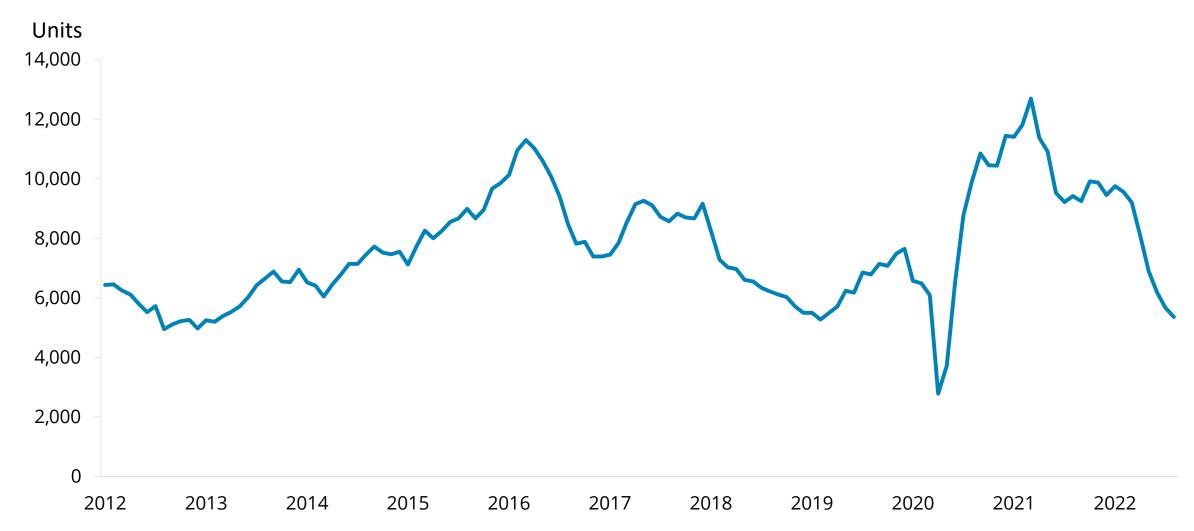

#### **MLS®** Residential Sales

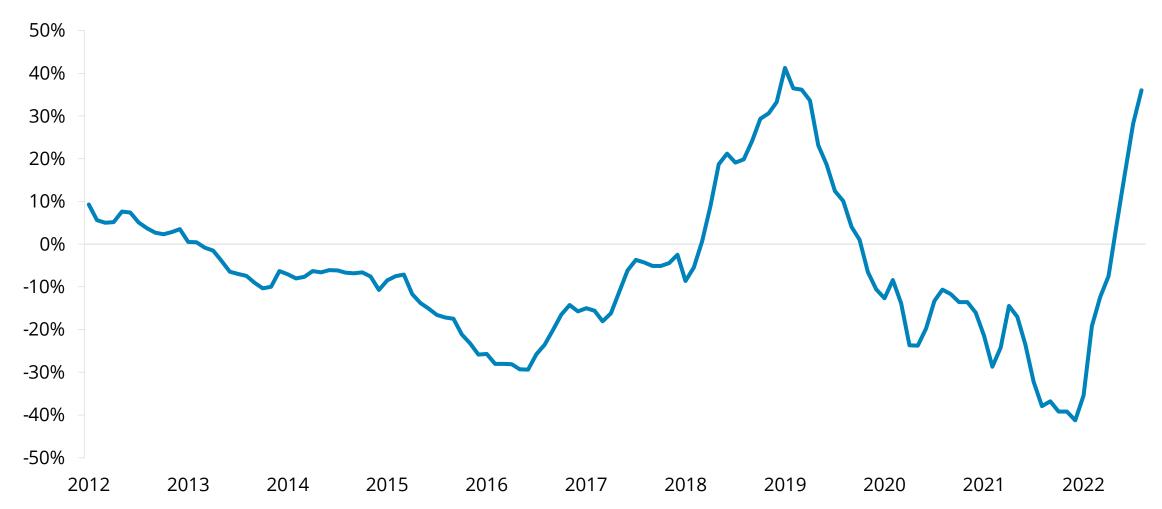
British Columbia, Seasonally Adjusted

British Columbia, YoY % Change

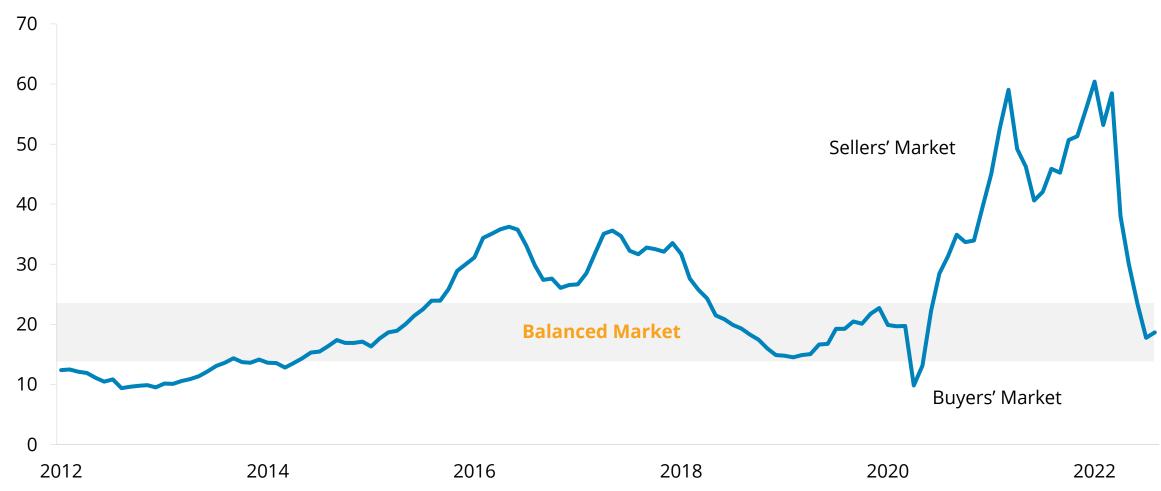




#### **MLS® Residential Market Conditions**

British Columbia, NSA

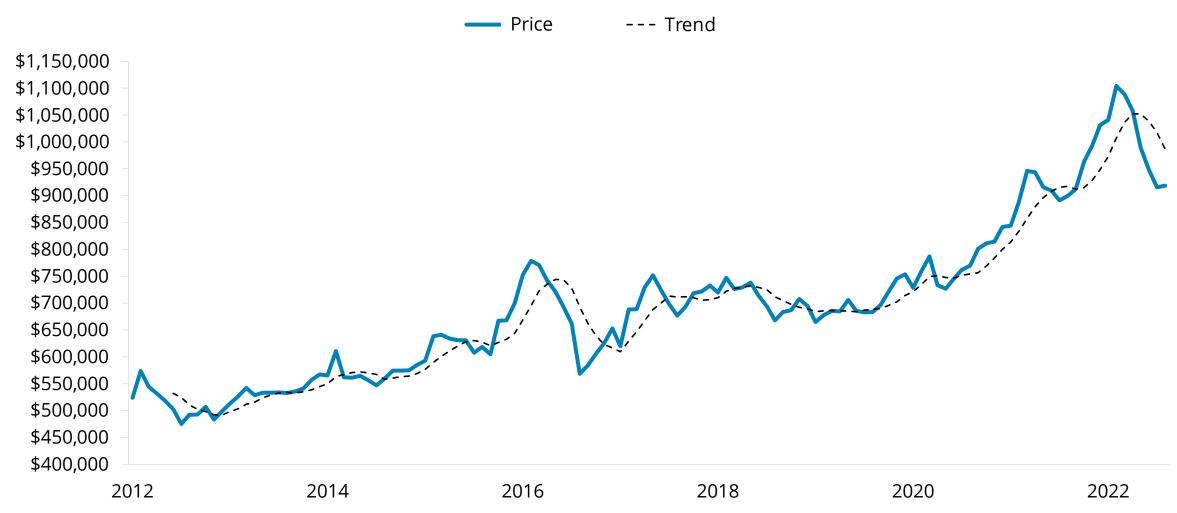
#### Sales-to-Active Listings Ratio
